PERMIT TO UNDERTAKE WORKS ON OR AFFECTING A HIGHWAY

This permit is required if you intend to occupy a road or highway to undertake works within the City of Clarence.

If the Works Supervisor or Site Manager cannot provide a copy of a current permit with any relevant documents, including traffic management plans, where required under the Act...

DO NOT PROCEED WITH ANY WORKS!

Contact your manager and advise them works cannot commence until such time as a permit can be produced, as fines and surcharges for a retrospective permit will apply.

IN RELATION TO THIS PERMIT,

ROADS AND HIGHWAYS INCLUDE:

- » Local highways.
- » Road reservations between property boundaries.
- » Any approved and constructed crossing, kerb, footpath, walkway, guttering, pavement or earth surface drain.
- » Any mall or public car park.

WORKS CAN INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

- » Any works on or under a road or highway for any purpose.
- » Any traffic management.
- » The use of a mobile crane or travel towers for building work.
- » The use of a concrete pump on the road for the purpose of discharging concrete/feeding to the pump.
- » The erection of barriers or other structures to protect pedestrians or regulate traffic.
- » The installation or removal of temporary traffic signals, signs etc.
- » Any public open space and laneway/ footway or access strip.

- » Placement of any object on a road for the purpose of preventing or inhibiting parking.
- » The deposit or dropping of any material or allowing any material to flow, fall, be dropped or in any other way be deposited.
- » The laying of underground services.
- » Making or reinstating a hole or excavation.
- » Erection of scaffolding or hoardings.
- » The placement of freight containers or rubbish skips on the road.
- » The use of any part of a road or highway as a holding yard.
